The night manager was advised of the violation.

On 8 October 2015 between 1930hrs-0030hrs(7:30pm-12:30am), your writer along with Inspector John Chrissomallis, conducted an investigation into a college night being held at the "Baltimore Sports Bar" located at 1400 Warner Street. Your writer received anonymous information along with a map of where buses were going to pickup college students leaving from the Towson area, heading to a college party being held the "Baltimore Sports Bar". With the assistance of Inspector Chrissomallis, he was able to conduct on site surveillance at a parking lot location in Towson, while your writer conducted periodic checks of the Baltimore Sports Bar at 1400 Warner Street. At 10 30pm, Inspector Chrissomallis then notified your writer of a group of college students that were now waiting at the parking lot in Towson. At 10 40pm, Inspector Chrissomallis then advised your writer that a school bus had just arrived and picked up a group of students. Inspector Chrissomallis advised your writer the school stopped at a local liquor store in Towson. After 15 min at the liquor store, bus proceeded into the City of Baltimore with its destination being the "Baltimore Sports Bar" located at 1400 Warner Street. At 11 40pm, your writer observed the bus arrive the "Baltimore Sports Bar", dropping off the group of college students that had been picked up only an hour prior in Towson. Your writer then notified Detectives John Garrett and Olufemi Akinwande of SES-Vice and advised them of the situation involving potential underage drinking at the "Baltimore Sports Bar". Your writer further more advised both Detectives to enter the liquor establishment, in an attempt to gain knowledge on possible underage drinking inside the liquor establishment. Detectives Garrett and Akinwande would later inform your writer of the underage patrons were getting marked with "X's" ontop of both hands. At one point Detective Akinwande observed a white male later identified as Blake Willis, M/W/20, 11/05/94 and a white female also later identified as Kelsey Grimes, F/W/20, 11/05/94, both of whom were observed to have black "X's" ontop of both the back of their hands. As described by Det Akinwande, persons' that were underage, were marked with a "X" ontop of their hands to indicate that these persons are under the age of 21. Det Akinwande then advises your writer that both Grimes and Willis was able to remove the "X's" from their hands. Detective Akinwande advised your writer that both Grimes and Willis was observed drinking a mixed alcoholic beverage. Given a clothing description of Grimes and Willis, your writer along with Inspector Chrissomallis entered the "Baltimore Sports Bar", in attempt to properly identify both Grimes and Willis. Your writer met with night manager, Ian Thomas Hanbrook, while Inspector Chrissomallis attempted to locate Grimes and Willis. Inspector Chrissomallis then located Blake Willis and advised your writer that he was 20 yrs of age, with a date of birth of 11/05/1994. Inspector Chrissomallis also stated the Blake Willis was in possession of a mixed alcoholic beverage. Blake Willis did not readily produce his identification to your writer due to the fact it would have revealed that he was under the age of 21. A few minutes later, Inspector Chrissomallis located Kelsey Grimes, who was also identified to be 20 years of age and also had a date of birth of 11/05/1994. Inspector Chrissomallis also observed her in possession of a mixed alcoholic beverage. Both Willis and Grimes were issued criminal citations for Minor being In Possession of alcohol. At that time the investigation was concluded.

**Report Facts:**

I Inspector Chrissomallis while on duty at approx. 1:38am on November 7, 2015 received a complaint (#15-00856371) from the Baltimore City 311 system for loud music at Tela-Marias which is located at 318 South Broadway in the city of Baltimore and state of Maryland. I arrived at the location at approx. 2:18 am. After observing for 2 min I entered the establishment. I observed approx. 20 customers inside the location eating and at least 10 drinking alcoholic beverages ranging from beer to what appeared to be mixed drinks. At that time I was approached by a gentlemen who identified himself as the owner. I made him aware of the violation and he stated that he is taking full responsibility and that he realizes his mistake. At that time he instructed the customers to leave the location and with his staff's assistance cleared out the restaurant. The owner explained that he just took over the establishment and was having a party and lost track of time. I explained to him that at 2:00 am there cannot be anyone drinking inside the location. He stated that he understands. I exited the location at approx. 2:30 am. I violated establishment for Rule 4.05 Prohibited Hours and Rule 4.18 Illegal Conduct. There was no evidence of loud music per original complaint.

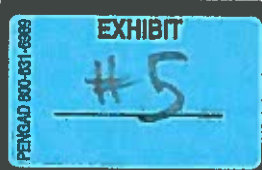
