Michael Jun Kim & Taeck G. Song, Globalscope, Inc. T/a J & J Discount Liquors, 5117 Park Heights Avenue – Class BD7 Beer, Wine & Liquor License - Violation of Rule 3.02 “Licensees shall cooperate with representatives of the Board, members of the Police Department, Health Department, Building Engineer's office, Grand Jury and representatives of other governmental agencies whenever any such persons are on official business” on October 19, 2009 (Re: Employee would not allow police officers to enter bar area of establishment for 30-35 minutes; uniformed officers had to be called for assistance); **Violation of Rule 3.03(c)** “Licensees shall keep on their premises records containing the legal names, aliases, addresses, ages, and Social Security numbers of all persons employed by them. Such records shall be open for inspection at all times by duly authorized representatives of the Board, the Police Department of Baltimore City, and other governmental agencies” on October 19, 2009 (Re: No employee records were available when requested by police officers); **Violation of Rule 5.03** "For purposes of this Rule, the Board considers all Class BD7 licenses as tavern operations. A tavern is defined as an establishment where alcoholic beverages are habitually sold for on-premises consumption. Such alcoholic beverages must be served at a bar or in a lounge area.... (b) ...The bar/lounge area must be operative for business at all times the premises is open to the public" on October 19, 2009 (Re: No bar stools of any kind for patrons to sit, bar shelves and three compartment sink not set up, personal dishes inside and around sink area)
